



The Closed Graveyard of St Margaret of Antioch Parish Church, Crick, Northamptonshire.

Introduction

A study in 2009 by Rachel Andrews of the Rugby Family History Group (RFHG) produced an important listing, in the form of an Excel spreadsheet, of all the gravestones in St Margaret's graveyard that were legible. However this listing only assigns plot numbers to the graves and although there is some pattern to the way in which the graveyard was covered, this was not mapped and there is no link between the physical location in the church yard and the plot numbers. There are quite few headstones that are now unreadable because the stone used has been eroded by the weather and lichen growth. Additionally there are gaps in the rows of graves where the headstones or markers no longer exist. Consequently it is not possible to gain any idea of the total number of remains that might be buried in the graveyard.

The church is built, as is typical, on an east/west axis with the spire at the west end. For the most part the graves in the church yard are organised in straight rows, easily seen by squinting down a line of graves. These rows are arranged in a north-south orientation and the actual graves in most cases lie to the east of the headstone, with the legend being inscribed on the west facing side. Thus when standing reading the headstone inscription the actual grave is on the other side of the headstone; easily verified if a footstone is present. This pattern changed in the early /mid 1900s so that the inscription faced the actual grave, as is the case today.

Burial practices have changed over the years. With the exception of people of importance, prior to about 1700 bodies were either buried on private land or temporarily buried and after a time the bones were disinterred and placed in the church or in an ossuary/crypt. Thus most church graveyards do not have gravestones dated before the 18th Century. Crick is no exception. The earliest readable grave is from 1745 and the majority of the gravestones are Victorian or later.

Aim

The object of this exercise was to map the rows of graves, identifying individual locations using a coordinate scheme (described below) and to interpolate the gaps in the rows to estimate the numbers of unmarked graves. The coordinates for each identifiable grave were recorded in a new column in Rachel Andrews' spreadsheet, linking her descriptions and plot number details (which are now less important) to physical locations.

Methods

The co-ordinate system uses three elements.

1. A capital first letter indicates the zone (zones A to J). The graveyard has been notionally divided into 9 easily identified areas, framed for the most part by pathways and the boundary walls. The only exception is zone D which has an imaginary line drawn along the east face of the church as its western edge. (see Map 1, the Zones).
2. A lower case letter identifies the rows of graves in a zone. In each zone the lettering always starts with 'a' at the **western side** moving eastwards.
3. Finally a number counting from the **south** end of the row to identify specific graves.

*Thus the code **Bf6** identifies a grave in zone B, in the sixth row (f) from the west edge of the zone and 6 graves from the south end.*

To collect this data strings were laid alongside standing headstones to define the rows. A number of measurements of the distance from centre of one headstone to the centre of the next show some slight variability in grave spacing. These measurements average around 1 metre, so for simplicity this was used as an approximation across the graveyard for the distance between grave centres. Using this value estimates of the numbers of graves in the intervals in the rows with no headstones were made. In a few locations a row appears to have been shortened and does not extend across the full width of the zone (eg Be, Ch, and Gm). These may have been used for shorter graves or stopped to allow for a readjustment in the alignment of the subsequent rows.

Standard score sheets were used to record the zone/row and count for each grave. Graves with readable inscriptions were cross referenced to the RFHG spreadsheet and had their plot numbers entered. Unreadable headstones were entered as a ? and putative grave locations were marked with an X, to give totals for each row.

A number of headstones were initially unreadable but with gentle scrubbing with water the inscription text could be read. Vegetation, often ivy, made reading difficult on some graves and was scraped or pulled off. Most graves, particularly the older ones, are no longer attended by family members and it is to be expected that with the passage of time the number of headstones that are unreadable will increase.

This approach copes with all the standard rows of graves. There are a small number of deviations from the regular layout, which are separately dealt with, for example the chained off plot of the Clark family which is half way along the south (church) side of zone C (see Appendix 2). Here the designation is FP/ (for family plot) followed by the zone letter and then the rows and numbers. In this case the nomination is FP/C, for the chained off area containing two rows of three graves. The normal rows start to the north of the plot and the graves in the plot align with rows c and d. So the graves in the FP (which are in alignment with the 'normal' rows) are given minus numbers to signify their position. Thus FP/Cd-2 indicates the row is d and the grave is 2 back from the row start. This is actually the large chest tomb within the chained off area. There are graves either side of it (FP/Cd-1 and -3).

Results and comment.

This study concentrates on the closed graveyard. Any headstones (or cremation plaques) mentioned in the RFHG study that are in the open part of the graveyard were not included in the mapping exercise and are only identified as being in Zone I (or J where the cremation plaques line the pathway).

The basic statistics from the survey are summarised in the following table:

Zone A was not mapped in the same detail as the others. This area has been cleared of headstones and now contains the War memorial, put in place in 1920 (see the Crick History Society's book 'Roll of Honour' for details of the memorial). In this zone there only remains three marked graves and a wall plaque near the church. One grave and the wall plaque are readable and the other two are illegible now. Some of the grave stones lining the path to the South entrance to the church may have originally been from Zone A. The estimate of the number of putative graves in Zone A is based on the spacing in Zone B.

420 headstones are still readable (that is 25% of the total number of identified plots), 105 graves have headstones that are now indecipherable (6% of the total number of identified plots), and we calculate that there are about 1200 putative, grave plots that are unmarked (69% of the total number of identified plots).

The total number of grave plots in the closed graveyard is estimated to be about 1740. Most of the readable headstones list 2-3, frequently more, people being buried in a single plot. So a conservative estimate as to the total number of individuals' remains in the graveyard as a whole would be 4000-5000.

The two pathways to the south and north doors of the church are partially lined on their east side with headstones and footstones which for unknown reasons have been removed from their grave plots. Where these are readable they are included in the listing. The earlier RFHG survey included a number of partially readable stones (listed at the end of appendix 3) some with plot numbers lying between Zone B and C. It is assumed that they were readable at that time along the north pathway. Interestingly two headstones (of

the Leatherland family) along this north path that are still readable were not in the original list.

In 2019 part of the boundary wall along zone H had to be rebuilt. During this work 28 footstones were discovered incorporated into the structure of the old wall. This find was described in detail in a History Matters article in Crick News (Issue 1, Spring 2020, p.5). For completeness the table of the findings from that study are included here as Appendix 4.

This History Matters article discussed a possible stonemason's error with the date (1791) on the W Dicey footstone found in the wall which did not tally with burial records. Only one grave for the Dicey family name has been found in the present study of the graveyard and that is a 1945 war grave in Zone H. So the mystery remains.

It is hoped that this new mapping and listing will be of future value to those wishing to locate their ancestors.

Appendix 1.

Map of the graveyard showing the zonation used in this study. The map also gives the ranges of the plot numbers from the RFHG study in each zone. From this it is apparent that the area designated as Zone D in this study was divided in two along the church axis, into a north and south section in the RFHG study.

This listing is a subset of the main RFHG spreadsheet and does not include the notes and relationships columns.

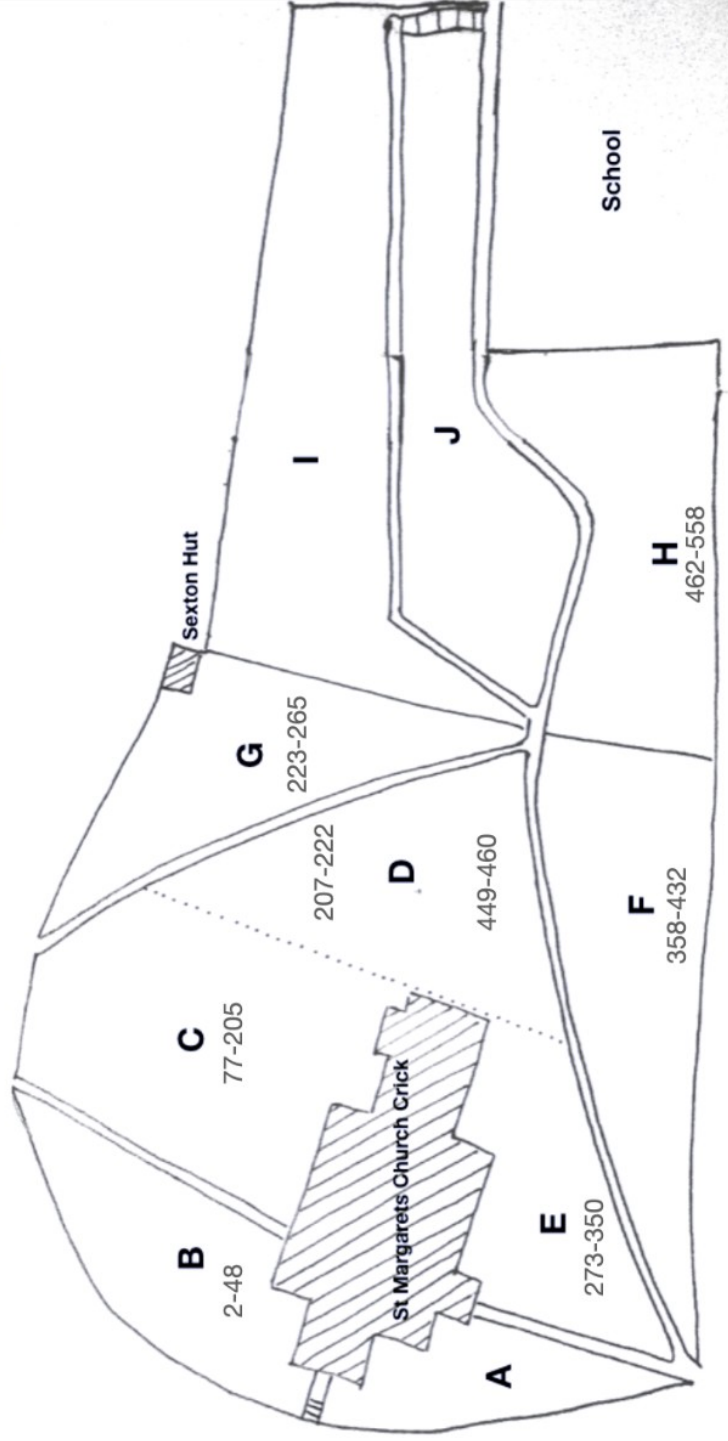

Mapping 'zones' for the St Margaret's graveyard and burial ground, Crick

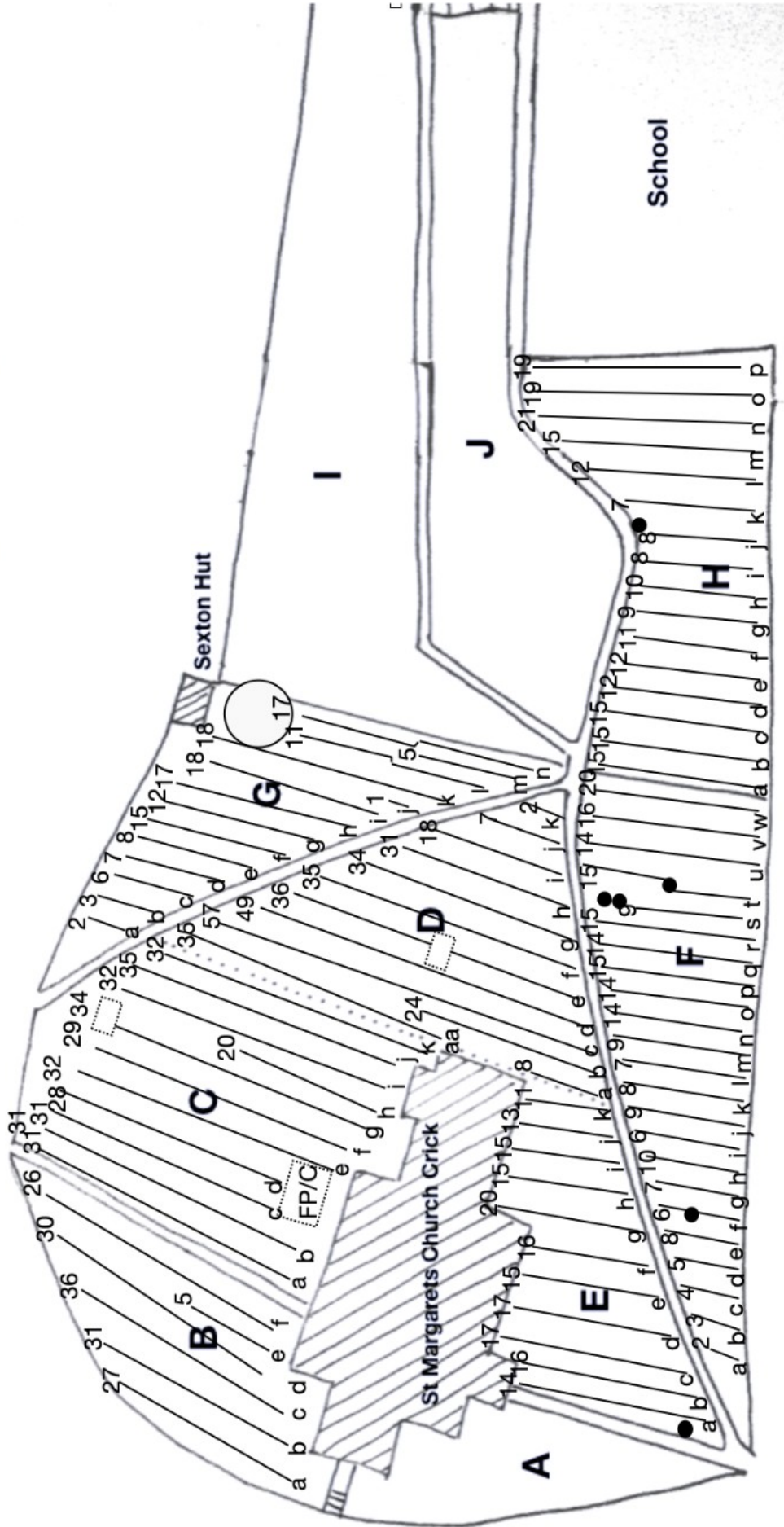
Numbers below zone letters shows the ranges of Rachel Andrews' plot numbers in the zone
